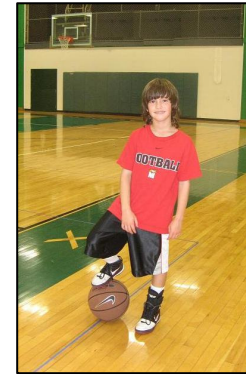

Meet the Honoree – Jacob Krause



Hi! My name is Jacob Krause, and I am 9 years old. I LOVE playing basketball and I dream of making the winning shot at the buzzer of a championship game.

In April of 2009, I was diagnosed with

Ulcerative Colitis. Before Colitis, I only took my allergy medicines. Now I have to take 5 medications a day, every day, probably for the rest of my life. I used to only go to the doctors when I was sick, or for my birthday checkups – now I go to the doctors often. I see a gastroenterologist who studies people's colons and helps them feel better. I have had several colonoscopies where I have to drink a lot of medicine so the doctors can put a camera into my colon to see where it is sick.

I hope that all of the money raised during this event will help the doctors find a cure so other people do not have to go through what I am going through now.

I am very thankful that the CCFA can help kids like me. Hopefully, **WITH YOUR HELP**, a cure can be found so I never have to run off of the basketball court before getting a chance to take that final shot.
